The Regional 2016 Cisco Networking Academy Asia Pacific and Japan NetRiders Skills Competitions are open to Cisco Networking Academy students in **Asia Pacific and Japan**. All participating countries in this region will compete on the same dates and times listed below.

This is a great opportunity for students to compete against other students to test their ICT/networking skills and gain recognition with potential employers.

The students may compete from any location for Round 1 but they will need to be **proctored at their academy for Round 2** and CCNA competitors will need to go to a **designated Cisco office for Round 3** in each participating countries. Instructors who have students competing should also register during the Registration period and they will be put in an Instructor-Observer role which will allow us to send them the Round 2 exam passwords a few days before Round 2. There are a few countries which will require students to go to a designated location for Round 2. Those countries will be posted on the competition pages when Round 1 results are posted.

This year, we are offering 3 levels of competitions (CCNA, CCENT and IT Essentials).

- The competitions will be offered in English only.
- Students may only compete in **one level** each calendar year.
- Students may only compete one time ever in each level (CCNA, CCENT or IT Essentials).
- Students should be **strategic selecting the competition level** that they meet all eligibility requirements for and that this is the best year to take that specific level (CCNA, CCENT, or IT Essentials).

Registration will be open from Tuesday, 10 May 2016 through Friday, 5 August 2016.

Competition KEY Who should enroll? **Competition content** APAC CCNA 2016 CCNA Currently enrolled in or Geared toward CCNA completed in last 10 months the certifications with a few IoE and 3rd or 4th CCNA course soft skills questions per round CCENT **APAC CCENT 2016** Currently enrolled in or Geared toward CCENT completed in last 10 months the certification with a few IoE and 1st or 2nd CCNA course soft skills questions per round IT Essentials APAC ITE 2016 Currently enrolled in or Geared toward IT Essentials completed in last 10 months the course content with a few IoE **IT Essentials course** and soft skills questions per round

Students will need an enrollment key to register. Here are the 2016 keys:

Instructors use the same keys to enroll in one, two or all three competition levels. On the competition pages, they will be in the Instructor-Observer role which allows them to view the list of students enrolled where they can sort by country or academy. It will also allow the Round 2 competitors to complete the Proctor Information Task selecting the Instructor as their Round 2 proctor. This is the only way the proctors will be sent the Round 2 exam passwords.

There will also be a **Practice Site** open during Registration and the entire competition period. This requires a separate key but the key is visible in the summary block by the link to register.
